Cherry Blossom Packages Are in Bloom in Capital

If you're headed to [Washington](#) for the 2009 National Cherry Blossom Festival, which runs March 28 to April 12 (www.nationalcherryblossomfestival.org), several hotel packages are worth considering.

The Willard InterContinental Hotel has a Very Cherry Willard package, which starts at \$349 a night and includes the choice of either breakfast for two, a second room at half price for children, a room upgrade or parking (www.washington.interconti.com).

At the Liaison Capitol Hill, an Affinia Hotel, the festival package starts at \$223 and includes a live cherry blossom branch, a basket of goodies to enjoy under the trees and 10 hand-made cherry blossom note cards (www.affinia.com/liaison).

And the Fairmont Washington's Cherry Blossom Package starts at \$189 and includes valet parking and note cards featuring the photography of Jake McGuire (www.fairmont.com/washington).

All nightly rates are based on double occupancy.
